Conflict Minerals Policy

The Manufacture of electronic components may contain various metals, including tantalum, tin, and tungsten, gold. These four metals are sourced worldwide, including the Eastern provinces of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) where millions have died.

In the U.S., section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act requires all companies to file an annual special disclosure with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission beginning in 2014 indicating if their products include metals sourced from the conflict region.

CW Industries does not directly purchase any Conflict Minerals from any source from the Conflict Region.
